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Platygastroidea is a superfamily of parasitoid wasps that contains a vast number of undescribed species and relationships between many of its genera are poorly understood. Here we address both of these issues for *Paridris*, and its putative sister genus, *Trichoteleia*, and demonstrate the synergy of monographic taxonomy and phylogenetic analysis. The faunas of *Paridris* in Africa, Melanesia, and the Malay Archipelago are revised, completing our revisionary work on this genus and contributing to a cosmopolitan persective on its diversity. The species-level analyses of Paridrisand *Trichoteleia* are the largest conducted to date for platygastroidwasps, and the first to directly compare morphological and molecular data in this group.
